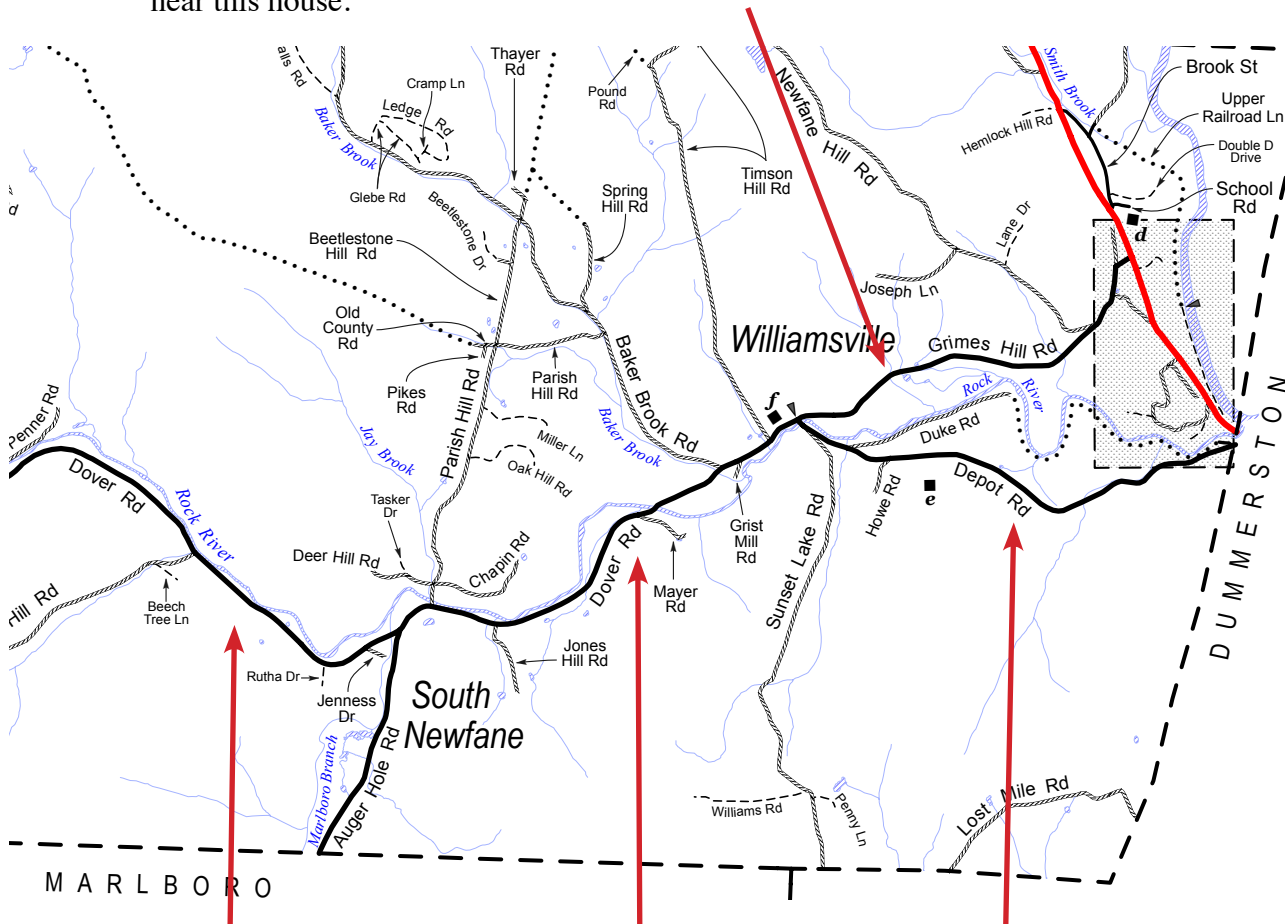


Dover Road & Williamsville Crossing Sites

Grimes Hill Road



Look for a large white colonial house next to the north side of Grimes Hill Road about 1/4 mile from Williamsville. The salamanders cross near this house.



Dover Road

Salamanders cross about a 1/4 mile stretch from the west side of the covered bridge up to a house on the right with a small pond in the yard. Another site is found in front of a red farmhouse on the right after you pass the South Newfane General Store as you're heading toward Dover. Amphibians cross to a pond near the house.

Depot Road

The site is located halfway between Williamsville and Route 30. From Route 30 the road is called Williamsville Road, it is a left-turn just before the Rock River Bridge. The amphibians cross near the white house on the north side of the road with #218 on mailbox. Many wood frogs cross at this site, as well as salamanders. Agile volunteers are always welcome here.
