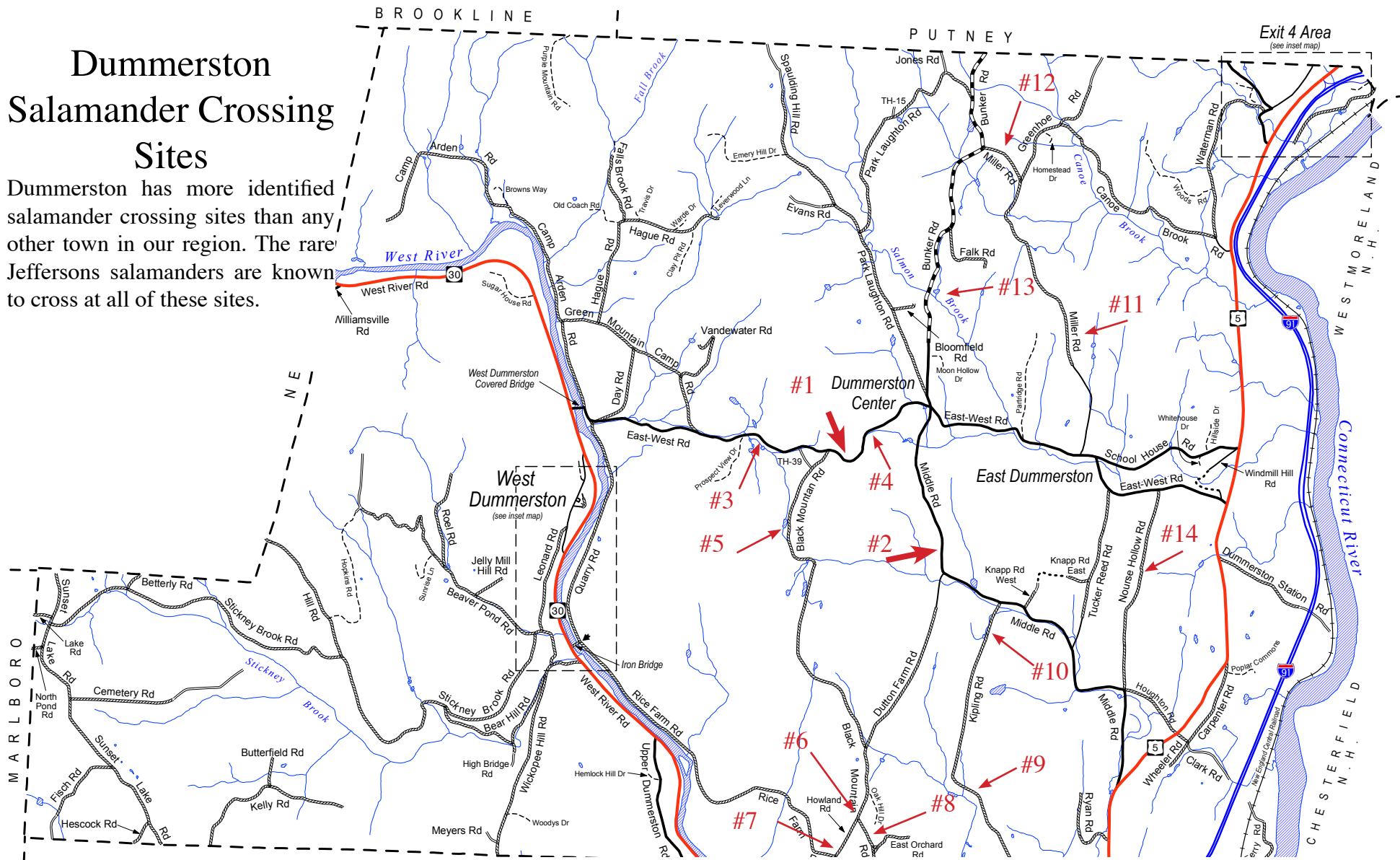


Dummerston Salamander Crossing Sites

Dummerston has more identified salamander crossing sites than any other town in our region. The rare Jeffersons salamanders are known to cross at all of these sites.



#1 East West Road Pool: This is a busy road and an important pool. Having this site covered is a top priority.

#2 Middle Road: The busiest section of this busy road is just north of Dutton Farm Road.

#3 & #4 East West Road: Smaller numbers of salamanders also cross East

West just above the dangerous corner above Prospect View Drive, and just over the hill from the main crossing site down toward Dummerston Center.

The remaining sites are on quieter dirt roads and are suitable for families with young children.

- #5** Hickins Mtn Mowings Farm pond
- #6** Howland Road/Black Mountain Road intersection
- #7** Rice Farm Road pond
- #8** Just above East Orchard Road
- #9** Corner by the Scott Farm
- #10** Kipling Road near Middle Road

- #11** Miller Road a bit beyond where the pavement ends
- #12** Little hill near Bunker Miller Road intersection.
- #13** North side of the bridge over Salmon Brook on Bunker Road
- #14** Wetland on Nourse Hollow Road
